I. Information on the total income of the population

According to preliminary data, in January-March 2025, the total volume of aggregate income of the population reached **222.4** trillion soums. In order to exclude the influence of price factors to calculate the real growth rate of income of the population, the consumer price index (CPI) is used - one of the important types of inflation indicator. Due to the change in consumer prices, the growth rate of the aggregate income of the population, compared to the same period in 2024, in real terms amounted to **109.8%**.

According to preliminary data, in January-March 2025, the total volume of aggregate income per capita amounted to **5.9** million soums, its nominal growth rate in the period under review reached **118.5%** and in real terms amounted to **107.6%**.

II. Total income per capita by region

The average per capita aggregate income of the population above the national average was observed in Tashkent city (**15 859.0** thousand soums), Navoi (**9 452.7** thousand soums), Bukhara (**6 364.2** thousand soums), and Tashkent (**6 134.5** thousand soums) regions. On the contrary, the indicators of total income per capita below the national average were recorded in Namangan (**3 966.0** thousand soums), Surkhandarya (**4 078.5** thousand soums) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**4 117.2** thousand soums), as well as Kashkadarya (**4 235.0** thousand soums), Jizzakh (**4 531.7** thousand soums), Syrdarya (**4 625.4** thousand soums), Fergana (**4 890.3** thousand soums), Samarkand (**4 970.2** thousand soums), Andijan (**5 077.8** thousand soums), Khorezm (**5 510.4** thousand soums) regions.


The highest rate of real growth of total income per capita was noted in Fergana – **14.5%**, Navoi – **10.1%** regions, as well as in Tashkent city – **9.8%**, Andijan – **8.6%** and Khorezm – **7.9%** regions.

At the same time, the real growth rates of total income per capita in Bukhara (**6.8%**), Samarkand (**6.6%**), Kashkadarya (**6.3%**), Surkhandarya (**4.3%**) regions, as well as in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**3.8%**), Syrdarya (**3.4%**), Namangan (**3.4%**), Tashkent (**3.3%**) and Jizzakh (**2.9%**) regions were below the national average.

III. Structure of total income per capita by republic and regions

In January-March 2025, according to preliminary data, the share of income from labor activity, including income of employees and income from self-employment, in total income was **57.7%**. The share of income from own production of services for own consumption in the total volume of total income of the population was **7.7%**, income from property - **4.7%**, income from transfers - **29.9%**.

In the total income of the regions, the largest share of income received from labor activity (income of hired workers and income from self-employment) was observed in the Navoi region (**70.9%**). On the contrary, in the Namangan, Kashkadarya, Khorezm, Surkhandarya regions, as well as in Tashkent city, Samarkand, Andijan and Fergana regions, it was below the national average.

The share of income from own production of services for own consumption and income from property in the structure of the total income of the population of the republic was insignificant, and the share of such income in Tashkent city amounted to **22.9%**.

In Andijan, Fergana, Samarkand, Surkhandarya, Kashkadarya, Khorezm, Namangan regions, as well as in the Republic of Karakalpakstan and Bukhara region, the share of income from transfers reached **30%** of the total income of the population, the share of this type of income in Navoi region is the lowest - **13.9%**.

IV. Growth rates and share of income of employees

In January-March 2025, the share of income of hired workers amounted to **30.0%** of the total aggregate income of the population. The growth rate of income of hired workers in the expired period reached **120.3%**, which ensured an increase in nominal income of the population by **6.1%**.

In terms of regions, it becomes obvious that the share and high growth rates of income of hired workers in Tashkent city, as well as in the Navoi region, have a significant impact on the total income of the population.

V. Growth rate and share of income from self-employment

The rate of income growth in the period under review reached **117.5%**, which ensured an increase in nominal income of the population by **5.0%**.

For example, in the Jizzakh region, the share of income received from self-employment in total income was **43.0%** and the nominal growth rate, compared to the corresponding period of 2024, reached **115.8%**. Similarly, in Tashkent region, the share of income received from self-employment in total income was **38.7%** and the nominal growth rate, compared to the corresponding period of 2024, reached **116.5%**. In Bukhara region, the share of income received from self-employment in total income was **38.3%** and the nominal growth rate, compared to the corresponding period of 2024, reached **116.4%**.

VI. Growth rates and share of income from transfers

Of no small importance in the structure of population income are incomes from transfers, consisting of social and other current transfers. The nominal growth rate of income from transfers, according to preliminary data for January-March 2025 compared to the corresponding period of 2024, amounted to **128.0%**. The share of transfers in the total volume of aggregate income of the population for the specified period amounted to **29.9%**.

According to preliminary data for January-March 2025, **34.7%** of income from transfers came from income from social transfers, **65.3%** of income came from other current transfers.

The share of pensions in the total volume of social transfers for January-March 2024 amounted to **84.0%**, benefits - **14.1%**, scholarships - **1.9%**.

In January-March 2025, the share of money transfers received from outside the republic in the total income of the population (taking into account other current transfers) amounted to **19.5%**.



**VII. The share of income from small business in the structure
of total income of the population**

According to preliminary data for January-March 2025, the share of income received from small businesses out of the total income of the population amounted to **53.9%**.

In the structure of the total income of the population, the share of income from small business had a significant weight in the following regions: Jizzakh - **61.8%**, Bukhara - **59.8%**, Tashkent - **59.3%**, Khorezm - **59.1%**, Samarkand - **57.9%**, Namangan - **56.4%** and Kashkadarya - **55.3%** regions. In Tashkent city - 46.9%, Navoi region - 48.9% and the Republic of Karakalpakstan - 49.2% the share of income from small business was less than fifty percent.

I. Methodological notes and metadata on total population income

The total income of the population includes monetary income and income in kind, consists of receipts that, as a rule, have the property of recurrence and are received by the household or its individual members on a regular basis, annually or at shorter intervals.

The following sources are used **in calculating the total income of the population**: statistical reporting data, the results of regularly conducted sample surveys of the economic activity of individual entrepreneurs and dehkan farms, household surveys using the methodology recommended by the World Bank, as well as summarized data from the Central Bank, the Ministry of Economy and Finance, the off-budget Pension Fund, the People's Bank and the Tax Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

In accordance with international statistical practice, for the purposes of aggregation, total income is usually divided into “primary income” and “transfer income”, which allows tracking the impact of institutional changes depending on the state of employment or the social security system.
